

INFORMATION FOR ROTATION UNITS

The Fort Irwin Dental Activity would like to enhance your NTC & Fort Irwin Training experience by providing read ahead information.

Units arriving to train at NTC & Fort Irwin are expected to bring their dental support team (dentist and dental assistant), equipment and supplies. The local dental clinics are not staffed nor provided additional supply funds to cover patient care in the training environment.

A Reception, Staging, Onward-Movement, Integration (RSOI) briefing is provided on RSOI 1 by a member of the NTC Surgeon's Office and a DENTAC representative. Once RSOI Briefing is complete, the Shuttleworth Dental Clinic OIC and NCOIC provide onsite orientation. The NCOIC will arrange a courtesy office call with the Senior Dental NCO, Commander and DENTAC Credentials Manager.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Rotation Training Dental Support Team: Provide emergency dental care to all rotational training Soldiers and the Soldiers of any slice elements supporting the rotational training unit. Soldiers in Dental Readiness Class 3 or 4 must be provided their treatment prior to arrival. On occasion the Dental Support Team may find it necessary to provide dental care at the local dental clinic. This arrangement must be coordinated and approved by the DENTAC Commander.

Fort Irwin Dental Clinic: May provide dental care to rotation Soldiers when coordinated and referred by Dental Support Team dentist.

CREDENTIALS: Dental Support Team dentist must contact their onsite Dental Credentials Office to coordinate the Request for Privileges. The Fort Irwin DENTAC Credentials Manager must receive the Interfacility Credentials Transfer Brief not later than 60 days prior to arrival. LESSONS LEARNED

Conduct function check of all equipment and order needed parts and supplies months before arriving to NTC & Fort Irwin.

Assure the dental assistant is available to the dental officer at all times and not primarily tasked in the motorpool, as runner, or driver.

Have a plan and be prepared if the dental van or generator becomes inoperable.

Bring a dental curing light and light cured glass ionomer (Fuji II LC, Vitremer) and ketacfil glass ionomer capsules.
